AUGUST 2022 OPERATING RESULTS

In August 2022, the Singapore Airlines (SIA) Group continued to see strong passenger demand across all route regions except for East Asia, where travel restrictions remain in place in some key markets.

SIA and Scoot, the two airlines in the Group, carried a total of 2.1 million passengers in August 2022, largely unchanged compared to the prior month. Group passenger capacity (measured in available seat-kilometres) was 1.1% higher than the previous month, and up by 110.3% compared to a year ago. The Group capacity reached 68% of pre-Covid- 19^1 levels during the month.

The Group passenger load factor (PLF) came in at 85.4% in August 2022. This was 2.0 percentage points lower on a month-on-month basis, and 67.9 percentage points higher on a year-on-year basis.

Cargo operations registered a load factor of 54.2%, or 33.4 percentage points lower year-on-year. Loads (freight tonne-kilometres) declined by 13.8% year-on-year, while capacity (capacity tonne-kilometres) expanded by 39.1% as increased passenger services resulted in higher bellyhold capacity.

At the end of August 2022, the Group's passenger network covered 99 destinations², the same as the month before. SIA served 73 destinations², while Scoot served 47 destinations².
