## **NOVEMBER 2018 OPERATING RESULTS**

In November 2018, SIA Group airlines' passenger load factor (PLF) improved 1.1 percentage points to 81.8%. Passenger carriage (measured in revenue passenger kilometres) increased 9.7% compared to last year, outpacing capacity (measured in available seat kilometres) injection of 8.2%.

Singapore Airlines' PLF improved 1.9 percentage points to 81.9%. Passenger carriage increased 9.2% compared to last year, against a 6.6% increase in capacity. PLF improved for all route regions except South West Pacific which registered a marginal decline year-on-year. RASK (revenue per available seat-kilometres) continues to remain resilient.

SilkAir's systemwide passenger carriage increased by 3.8% against a marginal capacity contraction of 0.2%. Consequently, PLF increased 3.0 percentage points to 76.9%, with improvements across all route regions.

Scoot recorded passenger carriage growth of 13.6% compared to capacity expansion of 17.9%, which led to a 3.1 percentage points decline in PLF to 83.2%. PLF improved for West Asia, while East Asia and Rest of World recorded declines as traffic did not keep pace with the increases in capacity.

Cargo load factor (CLF) was 3.4 percentage points lower, with cargo traffic (measured in freight-tonne-kilometres) declining 3.0% against capacity growth of 1.9%. All route regions registered declines in CLF as demand did not keep pace with capacity changes.

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
