Lau Guan Sam joined the SPD Sheltered Workshop in February 2022 under the artisanal apprenticeship programme where he picks up leathercrafting skills.

Guan Sam has autism spectrum disorder as well as intellectual and physical disabilities. When he first joined the SPD Sheltered Workshop, he had difficulties adapting to a new routine and a new environment. He also struggled stitching leather products with one functional hand.

The 20-year-old has received much support from a team of professionals such as his occupational therapist, social worker, psychologist, and workshop supervisor who worked closely with him and his family so that Guan Sam could quickly assimilate into the workshop's routine. They adapt training and instructions to suit Guan Sam's learning style. This mainly involves creating a structured routine with the use of visual support to establish a predictable rhythm. His OT has also customised some of the craft tools to accommodate his physical limitations and assist him with his day-to-day work.

Besides being able to stich leather products independently now, Guan Sam has also learned to manage his emotions. He has recently taken to marbling art and has been contributing his artwork to the design of various lifestyle products that SPD Artisan Collab is producing for sale. He takes great pride in his work which is evident in his excitement when he sees his artwork on the various finished products. The team is encouraged and inspired by the transformation of Guan Sam who has become a valued member of the SPD's Artisan team.
